Specific objectives:

- Identification, transfer and implementation of two social innovations in Pavlikeni municipality of Pavlikeni.
- Improving access to employment for job-seekers, representatives of the target group, incl. persons, including the long-term unemployed and people outside the labor market.



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Activities:

1. Preparation of specific analyzes and research of the experience of Spanish municipalities La Baña and Melide;
2. Adaptation and validation of identified social innovations;
3. Building partner capacity and stakeholders regarding the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of good practices and innovative approaches by organizing seminars and working discussions to encourage the exchange of experience, exchanges of information, good practice and innovative approaches between partners and other stakeholders;
4. Evaluation of results from the point of view of the applicability of the innovative elements;
5. Activities to disseminate results;
6. Organization and management activities;
7. Information and communication activities

Expected results:

Innovations will contribute to tackling some of the main issues and trends in the country, such as long-term unemployment, trends in ageing of the population and difficulty finding jobs for the unemployed.
